### Early Years (Nursery & Pre-Reception)

Due to the fees for our nursery and pre-reception provision remaining exempt from VAT, a separate schedule for these fees will be published to the website in due course.

## **Billing & Methods of Payment**

1. Termly – Fees must be paid in advance of the first day of term or late payment charges will apply. Fees may be paid by cheque, debit or credit card via our website, or bank transfer.
2. Monthly – Parents have the option to spread the costs of fees over 9 months if a standing order is set up. Please contact the Finance Office for more information.
3. Invoices are issued on a termly basis only.

### **Notes on the Fees:**

#### **Full, Day and Flexi Boarding**

International students requiring a visa are required to pay fees upfront as part of their visa application. There are additional charges for dry cleaning, trips, music tuition, exam costs, transport and EAL lessons.

**Flexi Boarding** Pupils aged 9 and over may be full, day or flexi boarders. Flexi boarding is available 7 nights a week and includes supper, prep supervision (week nights only), on site activities and breakfast. Flexi Boarding is subject to availability.

**Day Boarding** Pupils aged 9 and over may stay on at school until 9pm including supper, prep supervision and activities. Day Boarding is available Monday to Friday, subject to availability.

#### **School Hours**

**Reception – Year 2** – Core hours 8.25am -3.15pm. Breakfast can be booked from 7.30am and after 4.15pm, tea club runs from 4.15pm – 6.00pm. There is also a range of after school activities between 3.15pm – 4.15pm for which there is a charge if run by an external coach.

**Year 3 –Year 13** – Core term time hours are 8.25am-4.15pm. Breakfast can be booked from 7.30am and after school club runs from 4.15pm - 5.45pm.

#### **Additional Funding**

**Childcare Vouchers and Tax free childcare:** The school is set up to take childcare vouchers (CCV) and the Government's tax free childcare scheme. Full details of the appropriate childcare scheme for you can be found on the Government website, please contact the finance department if you need any further assistance. CCV can only be used for fees for the early year's children but can be used for some before and after school care and flexi boarding up until the age of 16.

#### **Dining**

**Breakfast Club** is open from 7.30am - 8.25am and may be booked in advance, or taken ad hoc and billed in arrears. Please note breakfast is served until 8.00am with the remainder of the period made up of the care element.

**Lunch and snacks (Reception to Year 13) are included in the fees.** Pupils are required to eat the meals and snacks at school which are prepared and cooked daily on site. Special diets can be catered for. Snacks include a drink and piece of fruit at break time and drink and biscuit at 4.15pm.

**Tea:** A more substantial tea is served at 4.15pm, prior to the after school clubs, which may be ordered in advance (see charges schedule).

#### **After School Clubs and Activities**

**After School Club (Year Reception – Year 2)** is available from 3.15pm-6.00pm and must be booked termly in advance (see charges schedule). A range of after school clubs are run between 3.15pm - 4.15pm as well as a light tea served after 4.15pm (see charges schedule). Pupils can also choose from activities such as tennis, ballet, judo which are run by outside staff and are charged for separately. All chargeable clubs must be paid for at the time of booking.

**After School Clubs (Year 3 – Year 13)** are available from 4.15pm-5.45pm each day. Pupils can choose from a wide range of activities and there is no additional charge for clubs run by school staff. Clubs run by outside staff are charged and must be paid for at the time of booking.

#### **Exam Fees and Work Experience**

Exam entry fees and work experience costs are charged.

#### **School Transport**

We operate several bus routes (subject to numbers) to and from Sherfield each day, coming in from areas such as Fleet, Camberley, Mortimer, Shinfield and Basingstoke. Please note that the cost of transport is billed termly in advance and no refunds can be made for any journeys not taken.
